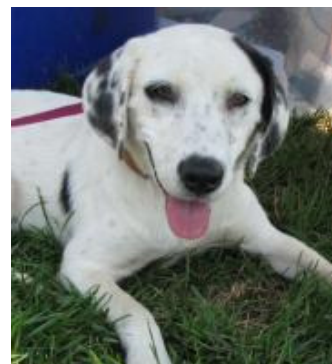


#2025 Tyler (Domestic Short Hair-mitted)
