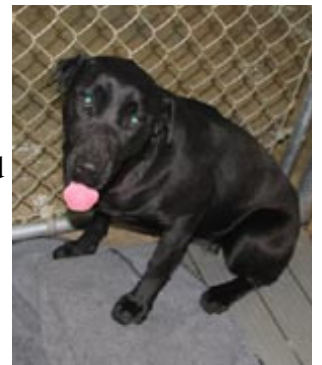


#271 Arnie-Sponsored (Tabby - Brown)
