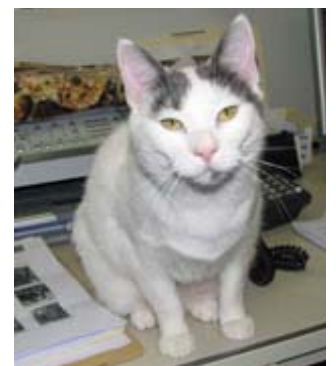


#24 Joey-Sponsored (Dachshund *Mixed*)

#2034 Lou-Sponsored (Domestic Short Hair-orange)

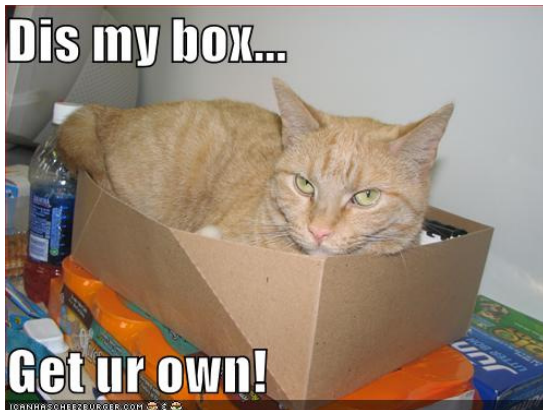
