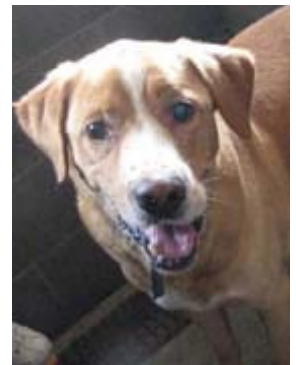


#221 Ava-Sponsored (Tabby – Grey)
