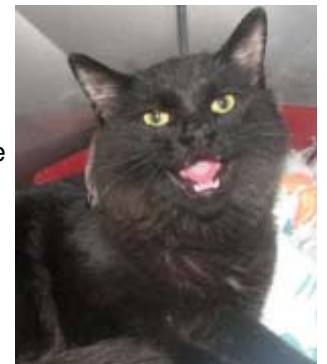


#39 Jada-Sponsored (Beagle)

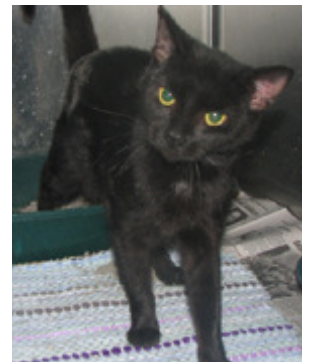


#129 Lyla-Sponsored (Shepherd Mixed)
