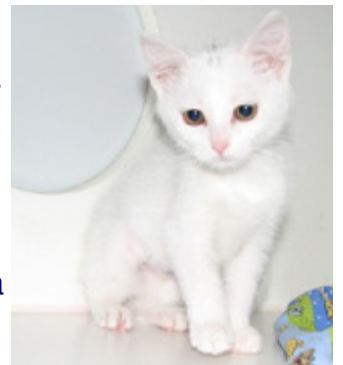


#270 Nicki-Sponsored (Beagle)

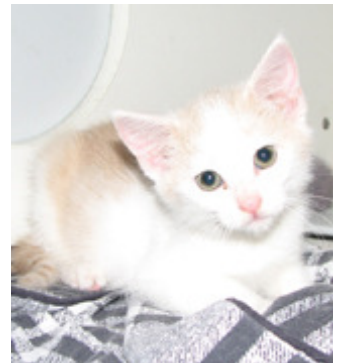


#1151 Darby-Sponsored (Labrador Retriever *Mixed*)
