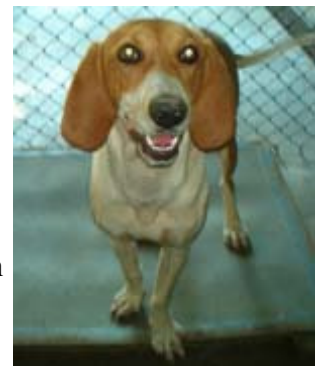


#230 Precious-Glomarr (Domestic Medium Hair-black and white)
